Suggested answers

Ayla-Su: She does not always understand the questions she is asked, but uses appropriate phrases to say so. She works well on the task with Maksim. She could try to give longer answers to questions.

Maksim: He speaks with some fluency and uses some good vocabulary. He could also extend his answers in some cases and work on grammatical accuracy.
