



Alba, the orangutan

Alba was born in Indonesia in 2012. But she wasn't a normal orangutan – Alba was different because she was an albino. She was completely white! Unfortunately, hunters captured Alba when she was very young. They put her in a cage in their village. Then, in 2017, an animal charity rescued her. 


