



Alba, the orangutan

Alba was born in Indonesia in 2012. But she wasn't a normal orangutan – Alba was different because she was an albino. She was completely white! Unfortunately, hunters captured Alba when she was very young. They put her in a cage in their village. Then, in 2017, an animal charity rescued her. They had a competition to choose her name and 'Alba' won. In 2018, the charity moved Alba to a special reserve for her protection.

Migaloo, the humpback whale

Migaloo is a white whale. There aren't many white whales in the world. People saw Migaloo for the first time in Byron Bay, Australia, in 1991. 'Migaloo' means 'white' in the local aboriginal language. Scientists think that he was born in 1986. Migaloo is a male. Scientists knew this because he sang! Male whales sing loud songs!
