Their car is blue.*

*Is Simon from the UK? Yes, he is.  
Are Isabella and Martine friends? Yes, they are.

#### Language in action

##### Whose + possessive pronouns

Which language does the vlogger use?

When we want to ask about who things belong to, we say *Whose*.

Whose sunglasses are these?

*They're mine. They're yours.*

Whose calculator is that?

*It's his.*

Whose pencils are those?

*They're his.*

Whose pen is this?

*It's his. It's ours. It's theirs.*

#### Use it!

Look and ask who the things belong to.

*Whose calculator is this?*

*It's hers.*

Now you try.

*Whose pen is this? It's his.*

*Whose books are these? They're theirs.*

*Whose ruler is that? It's his.*
