### ONION SOUP

**INGREDIENTS**

- butter
- 2 large onions
- 2 slices of bread
- 2 tablespoons of grated cheese
- 1 tablespoon of flour
- 500 ml of water



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**Method**

Chop the onions and fry them in the butter. Stir in the flour. Then add the water. Boil for 15 minutes. Pour into bowls. Toast the bread and place on top of the soup. Place the cheese on top of the bread. Grill or bake for five minutes.

### APPLE CRUMBLE

**INGREDIENTS**

- 5 large apples
- a pinch of salt
- 300 g flour
- 175 g sugar
- 200 g butter



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**Method**

Mix the flour, salt and sugar in a bowl. Add the butter and blend together until it looks like breadcrumbs. Peel and chop the apples. Put them in a baking dish. Spread the crumble mixture on top. Bake at 180 °C for 40–45 minutes. Serve with custard or cream.
