The Story of Mary Anning

Mary Anning was born in England in 1799. She had a brother named Joseph. The family lived by the ocean. Their father collected fossils. Mary and Joseph liked fossils too, and they helped their father to find them.

When Mary was eleven, her father died. The family was very poor. Mary sold some of her fossils. The money helped her family.

When Mary was twelve, there was a terrible storm. Part of the cliff fell into the ocean. Mary and her brother saw a fossil in the cliff.



It was enormous! At first, they thought that it was a crocodile. In fact, it was an ichthyosaurus. It was Mary's first important discovery.

When Mary was 22, she found the first complete fossil of a plesiosaurus.

For example, she found a fossil of a pterodactyl. Mary Anning became famous around the world.



