This section prepares students for the lesson by asking a warm up question related to the picture.

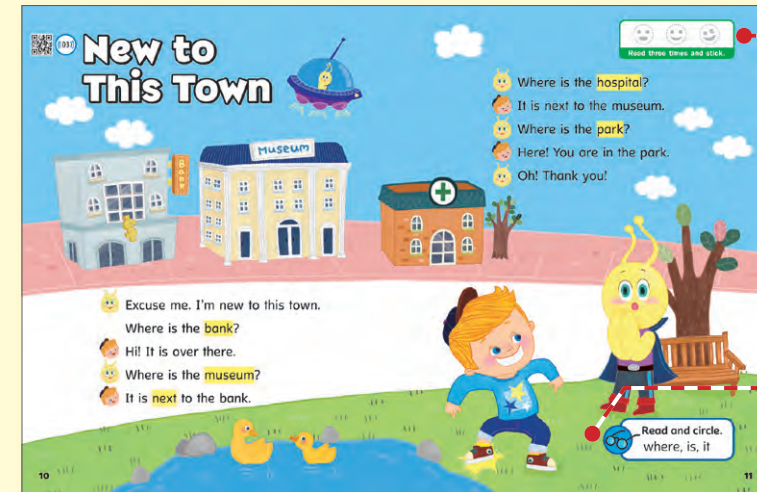


Key Words

This section engages students by asking them to identify key words or to share their personal experiences or opinions about the big picture.

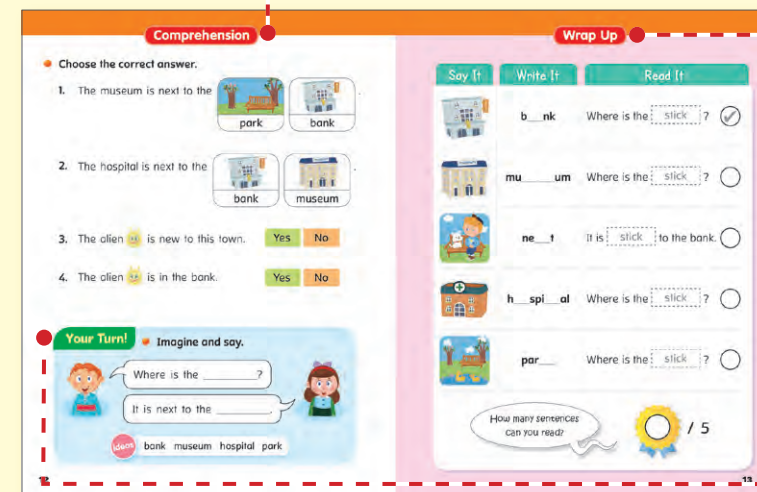
