Imagine a world without wheels. Before wheels there were no bikes, no clocks, no windmills, no engines. Can you think of more things with wheels?

The first wheels appeared more than 5,000 years ago. They were solid and round. The Sumerians of ancient Mesopotamia put these wheels on their carts. They also used wheels to grind flour for making bread and they used wheels to make pots.

In 1888, John Boyd Dunlop invented a tyre with air in it to put on the wheel. We still use Dunlop's invention today.



Britain is a land of castles. Some are very old. Some castles are inhabited (that means people live in them). Some castles are only ruins today.

Here are three famous castles in England.



William the Conqueror and his Norman army built a castle at Windsor in 1080. They used earth and wood. In later centuries, people used stone and made the castle bigger. Windsor Castle is near London, and the Queen lives here sometimes. The British Royal Family often spend Christmas at Windsor.






